Payment Information

All first-year madrichim work as volunteers. The payscale for returning madrichim is as follows:

2nd-year	\$180	\$90

KULAM Advocate

Work in a classroom helping student(s) with special needs read, focus on assignments, get from place to place, or pull out to do special work. Working one on one with another person can be very rewarding and meaningful! Training will be provided.

Rosh Madrich/a (Head Madrich/a) - (Sundays 9:30—12:15)

The Rosh Madrich/a position is a leadership role for 10-12th grade madrichim who have been in the program for at least 2 years.

Responsibilities:

- Meet with the Madrichim supervisor each Sunday morning
- Lead a meeting for your assigned madrichim to share information and check in each week.
- Track attendance
- Provide peer feedback and support
- Help with all school programming and special events
- Spend time in each classroom/area you are assigned on a rotating basis

Avodah - Service to the Community: Additional Opportunities for Madrichim

Shir Tzion Choir Assistant - (Sundays 9:00-9:30/ performances)

- Shabbat Evening Participation Dates; 1st Fridays/Month (5:30-7:30pm)
- This position pays \$72/year extra

Music Assistant – (Sundays 9:30 – 12:15)

Photographer

Sundays 9:15-12:15 Weds. 4:30-5:45 Weds. 5:45-7:15 (*11th & 12th graders only*)

Tot Shabbat - The second Shabbat morning each month (9:30—12:30).

- This position is paid \$15.75 per Tot Shabbat
- This is NOT a commitment for every Tot Shabbat. Scheduling will be done through Cantor Strauss-Klein

Office Assistant - Greet visitors and help locate information, answer the phone, help make copies, deliveries/collections at classrooms.

Sundays 9:15-12:15 Weds. 4:30-5:45 Weds. 5:45-7:15 (*11th & 12th graders only*)

Religious School Greeter - (Sundays 9:00-9:30) Answer doors and greet families as they come into the Religious School on Sunday mornings.

- This position pays \$50/year extra

Sunday Childcare - (Sundays 9:15-12:15) Work with the childcare teacher, maintain a safe and fun Jewish environment, serve snack, change diapers, play games, do holiday crafts.

Noar Tzion Assistant - (Schedule based on events, generally Sundays 12:15 - 2:30/3:30) Assist Noar Tzion advisor by helping to set up, clean up and supervise 4th-6th graders at youth group events. This position pays \$20 per event.

JYG Assistant - (Schedule based on events, generally Saturday afternoons/evenings) Assist JYG advisor by helping to set up, clean up and supervise 7th and 8th graders at youth group events. This position pays \$20 per event.

Gemilut Chasidim - Acts of Loving Kindness

Foodshelf Assistant - (Sundays 9:15-12:15) Visit classrooms to collect food, count and record items, pack and shlep food, make posters.

Shabbat Childcare – (scheduled separately with Larry Solomon; Friday evenings 6:30-8:30 or Saturday mornings 9:45-12:00) Assist with childcare.
