### **Lirdof Tzedek: Pursuing Justice in Challenging and Inspiring Times**

Class Dates: Sept. 26, Oct. 10, Nov. 7 & 28, Dec. 5 & 19, Jan. 9 & 23, Feb. 6 & 20, March 6 & 13, April 3 & 24, May 1 & 15.

The prophet Amos envisions a world where "justice wells up like water, and righteousness like a mighty stream." We will study what the Jewish tradition teaches us about some of the most pressing issues of our time, in our own community, in the United States, in Israel and beyond and how we can use the power each of us has to create the changes we want to see.

This class will be taught by **Jacob Kraus** who recently joined the Jewish Community Action staff as Community Organizer following three years of social justice advocacy, organizing, education and leadership development work at the Religious Action Center of Reform Judaism.
