Our High Holy Days services will follow last year's schedule with a few updates. This page explains the three ways to participate.

Guide to Places and Platforms:

- **In-Person:** Most of our services and programs will be in person at Mount Zion. Members and those who sign up for the High Holy Days will pick up pre-printed nametags at the Summit Avenue entrance (or kitchen door for accessibility) when first arriving. Please wear these nametags while in the building for all of the High Holy Days. See *p. 3 for our Covid-19 protocols*.
- **Streaming:** You can view all of our in-person services from home through Mount Zion's website www.mzion.org or on Mount Zion's public [Facebook page](#). All live streamed services will be available for viewing afterwards on the website and the Facebook page.

At the time of the service, simply click the arrow to start the service. It should be that easy! We will help you if you need support. We will provide a phone number closer to the Holy Days.
- **Zoom:** We will have a Zoom room available during most of our services for those who wish to pray from home in a more engaged, interactive community. Some "online only" gatherings during the High Holy Days will be via Zoom but can also be viewed via live streaming.
